

## DUFC Club Colours

### Details

#### Criteria

This is a DUFC award to recognise fencing achievements. There are two criteria for the awarding of club colours and any applicant must fulfill both criteria, only results achieved at events while registered for an event as a DUFC fencer and during a fencer's time as a student or in the season of their 'year of grace' are eligible. A club member can only win Club Colours once, even if they fulfill the criteria more times. The criteria are as follows:

1. Having been selected for and appeared as part of the DUFC team, at least as a substitute, at both an Intervarsities and a UCD Colours Match.
2. Having collected a minimum of 200 points on the 'Club Colours Ladder' through participation in Novice or Senior Open events in Ireland. All points must be collected in one weapon. Points to be awarded as follows with points only achievable in one category for any one event (i.e. one cannot both get 7 points for entering a Senior Open event and the 12 points for getting a DE win at the same event):
  - Taking part in a novice events: **3 points**.
  - Winning a bronze or silver medal at a novice event: **4 points per medal**
  - Winning a novice event: **7 points**.
  - Taking part in a Senior Open event or Student Championships: **7 points**.
  - Winning a DE at a Senior Open event or Student Championships: **12 points**.
  - Winning two DEs at a Senior Open event or Student Championships: **20 points**.
  - Winning a bronze medal at a Senior Open Event or Student Championships (non-National Circuit, only applicable with at least one DE win): **35 points**.
  - Winning a bronze medal at a National Circuit Event (only applicable with at least one DE win): **45 points**.
  - Winning a silver medal at a Senior Open Event (non-National Circuit) or Student Championships: **55 points**.
  - Winning a silver medal at a National Circuit Event: **60 points**.
  - Winning a Senior Open Event (non-National Circuit) or Student Championships: **100 points**.
  - Winning a National Circuit event: **200 points**.

It is the responsibility of each fencer to keep track of their own results and points.

In most cases the role of the committee is simply to check results and rubber stamp those applications that fulfill the criteria. In exceptional circumstances, however, the committee reserves the right to withhold the awarding of colours when, with a two thirds majority, they feel that an applicant would be a poor representative of the club and not someone whose achievements they wish to recognise. Those rejected in such a way are free to apply again in any other years in which they are eligible.

Awards will normally be presented at the Club AGM.

**There is a €5 charge to fund the lapel pin that is presented to those who are awarded Club Colours. This must be paid in advance. The club treasurer should be contacted regarding payment ([dufencing@gmail.com](mailto:dufencing@gmail.com)). We would gently invite those who feel they can afford more to take this opportunity to make a larger donation to DUFC (suggested amount: €50). This larger donation is not mandatory.**
